



The Great Florida Birding & Wildlife Trail is a network of 510 premier viewing sites in Florida, which is along the Atlantic Flyway (a 3000-mile migration pattern from the Arctic to the Caribbean). In and around Titusville, we see an amazing diversity of species during spring and fall migration, in addition to the resident species that live here year round.
